



Route Information

Route Name Clough Head and Great Dodd

A little visited high level route with spectacular views stretching from Blencathra, Bassenthwaite, Derwentwater, to the Helvellyn range (and much more). On a good day you can even see the sea in the distance. Path finding can be difficult in misty conditions. The route is best done as shown. The steep ascent of Clough Head from The Old Coach Road (3) is on a clearly visible path, though it is not on the map. It is recommended not to use the path from Calthow Pike to Mosedale Beck Bridge (2), though it looks like an obvious choice. It is a wet, indistinct path, and there are "invisible" holes, which make walking there a rather unpleasant experience. There is a small, free car park at the beginning of the walk by The Old Coach Road. You are welcome to take this with you and/or a laminated map.
