Three Dodds

Starting from Dockray or the small car park by The Old Coach Road, this is circular walk over Great Dodd, Stybarrow Dodd and Watson Dodd, returning to Dockray via Sticks Pass and the miners path around Glencoyne. This is a proper highlevel walk with excellent views, and significantly fewer walkers than neighbouring Helvellyn. It is mostly grassy under foot, and relatively easy walking, but navigation can be difficult, especially with low visibility. This walk can be combined with "Clough Head and Great Dodd" walk by the energetic. You are welcome to take this with you and/or a laminated map.
